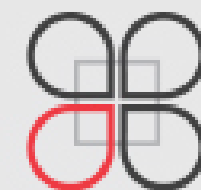

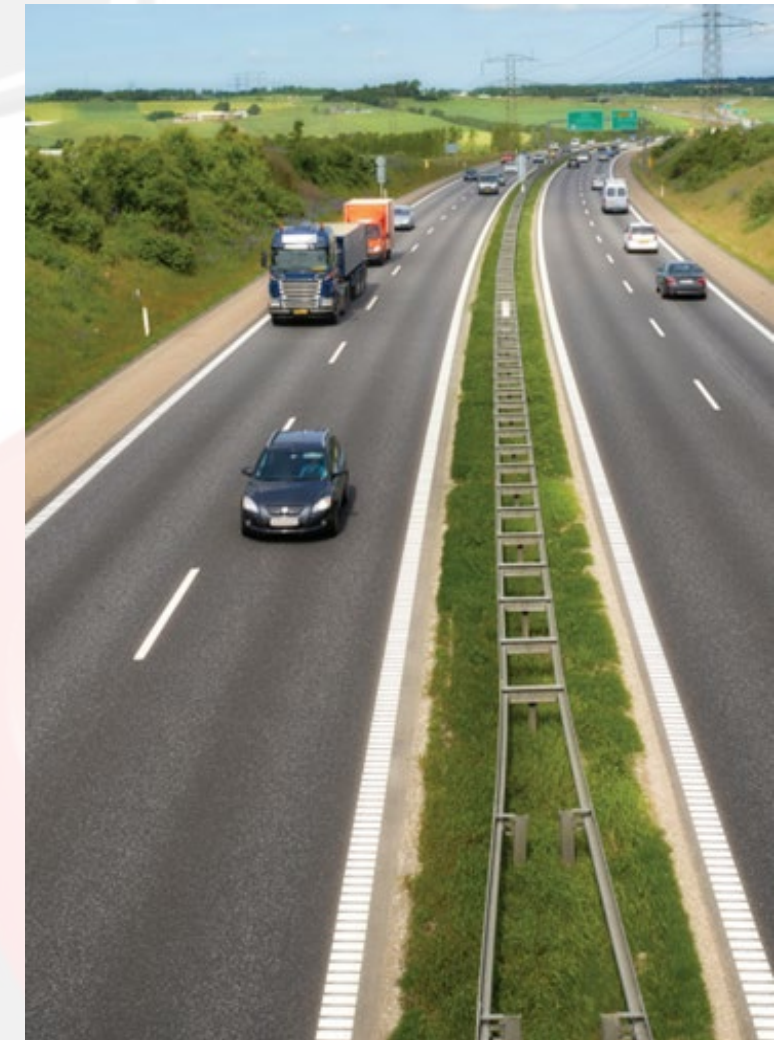

Our Objectives Ultimately Transcends into Ensuring:

- ❑ That as a Council, we understand and internalize members' and owners' concerns about asphalt quality issues, such as premature cracking;
- ❑ Improvements to industry's relations with and outcomes for road owners; and
- ❑ Work towards continuous improvement in industry performance as it relates to asphalt quality.



Some Municipal Asphalt Matters in Consultation

At Partnership levels with the OPS Pavement committee, and OAPC – Good Roads (GR) Municipal HMA Liaison committee:

- ❑ **OPSS.MUNI 305 and 1103, and the Asphalt Code of Practice** – Recommendations to Mirror the provincial 1103 spec for references to solvent-free emulsified asphalts.
- ❑ **Request to Replace OPSS.MUNI 310 with MUNI Version of OPSS 313** – The current OPSS.MUNI 310 is dated, and is not always clear about what testing and acceptance procedures are required.
- ❑ **OPSS.MUNI 1151** – Seeking to bring the standard closer in line to the provincial specification.
- ❑ **OPSS.MUNI 1003** – Reviewing the blending method for sampling/testing aggregates for physical properties.

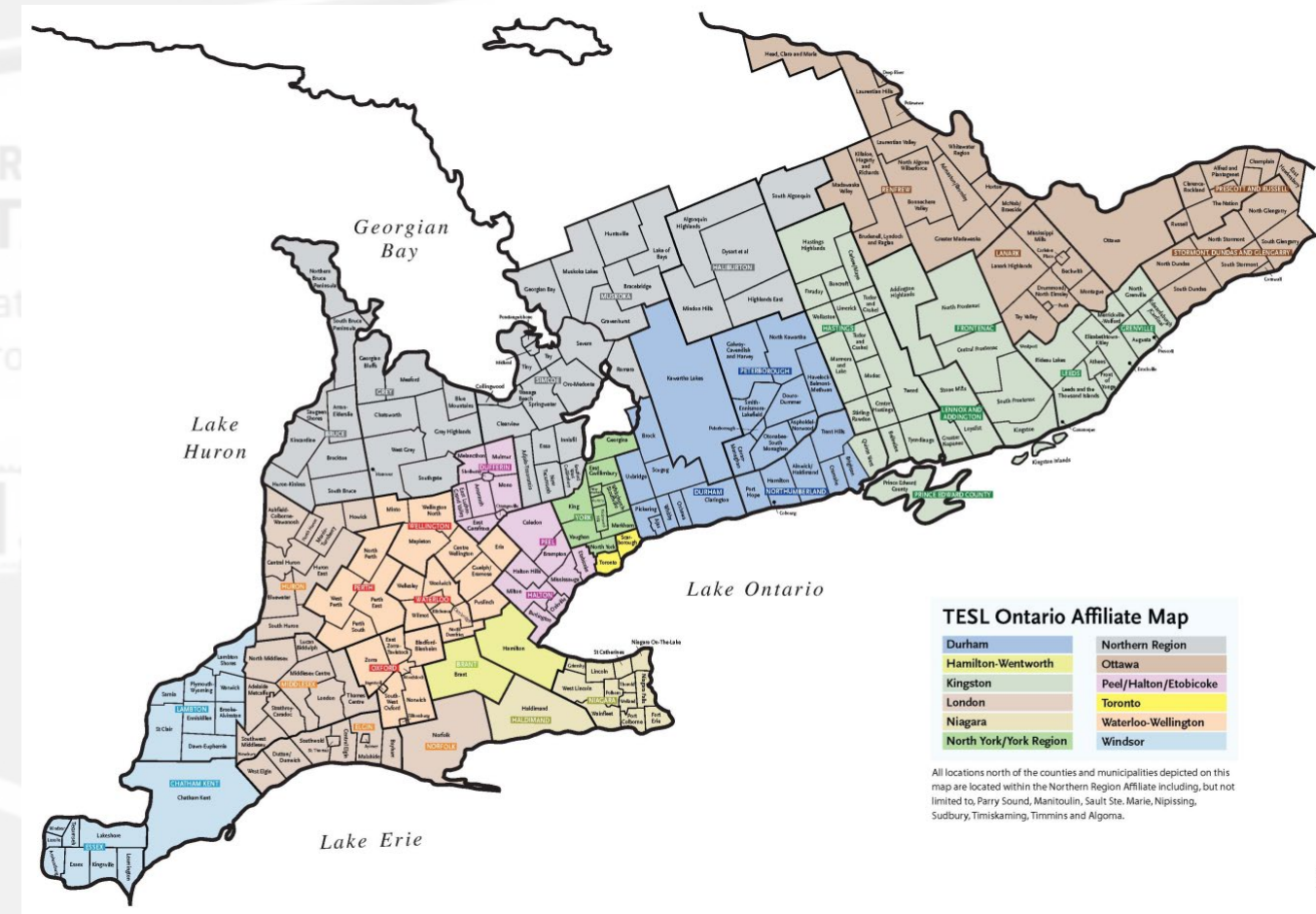
□ **The Asphalt Technical Symposium (ATS) is open to Municipal participation**

- The symposium provides a platform for education on the specific elements of technology necessary to achieve high performing asphalt pavement including materials, design and construction practices, unbiased technical discussions, sharing, and connectivity between leading asphalt technical experts.
- The ATS agenda explores industry's continued focus on recovered asphalt testing, and pathways towards mix performance testing in Ontario.
- The **"Ontario Asphalt Expert Task Group (OAETG)"** was birthed through the ATS, and consist of very motivated individuals at all levels of responsibility, who continue to champion the objectives of excellence in asphalt pavements.

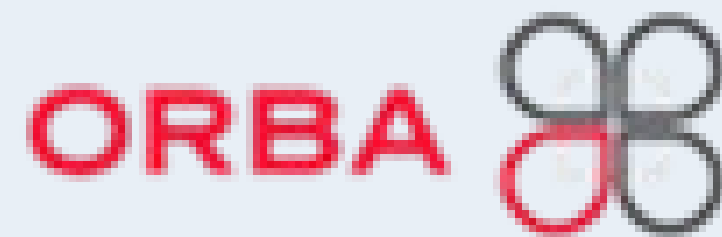
