



Video Shooting Tips



You will submit a maximum 5-minute video on a standard USB or DVD showing the plant/site during full operation.

Here are a few tips to help you in creating your video:

- Keep the camera steady!
- Provide both wide angle and close-ups shots of each aspect of the operations you are shooting.
- Each shot should be 10 – 15 seconds in duration.
- The entire video should be no longer than 5 minutes.
- If possible, try to shoot your video while standing on the ground, using a tripod and not while driving.

Your video must include views of the following:

- a) Cold feed bins
- b) Stockpiles
- c) Loaders
- d) Trucks
- e) Drum/dryer
- f) Batching tower
- g) Silos
- h) Stack
- i) Tanks
- j) A 360-degree panorama from the top of the silo
- k) Trucks being loaded from plant and/or silos
